How Can I Pay My Taxes?

No Contact / No Wait Payment Options

Avoid waiting in line by using one of the no contact / no wait payment options this year:

Mail

Payments can be mailed to the City at 7426 Hubbard Avenue, Middleton, WI 53562 using the return envelope enclosed with your tax bill. Please be sure to include the payment stub. Payments postmarked by January 31, 2023, will be considered timely.

How Can I Get a Receipt?

Send a stamped, self-addressed envelope with your complete tax bill and payment. Copies of tax bills are available online at accessdane.countyofdane.com. You can also view your payment history and download or print copies of receipts from Access Dane after the payments are updated in the beginning of January and the beginning of February.



Drop-Boxes

A drop-box is available 24/7 in the Library parking lot. A second drop box located inside the City Hall lobby is available Monday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., excluding holidays. Payments placed in both drop boxes will be processed daily.

Online

Payments can be made online through a third-party processor. This service is available 24 hours a day up to **January 25, 2023**. No payments will be accepted after that date in order to allow time for bank transaction processing. Go to www.cityofmiddleton.us and click **PROPERTY TAX PAYMENTS**. Do not make property tax payments on your utility account. Credit cards are not accepted.

When Are My Taxes Due?

The first installment for real estate taxes and the full amount of business personal property is due by January 31, 2023. All real estate tax payments made after January 31 should be made payable to and mailed to the Dane County Treasurer.

Important Reminders

- Include your payment stub or a copy of your tax bill with your payment.
- If you would like a receipt, include a self-addressed stamped envelope.
- Make payments to: **City of Middleton**
- Do not include any other payments with your property tax payment.
- If your escrow check is made out to you and the City of Middleton, endorse the back of the check before submitting.
- Verify that the payment amount is written on the check correctly.
- The City returns checks rejected by the bank due to errors.
- To correct the tax bill mailing address, note the change on the portion of the tax bill included with your payment.
- The City cannot change property addresses

City Hall Hours

- City Hall is open Monday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- **City Hall will be closed on: December 23, 26, 30, and January 2 & 16**
- Payments placed in the drop box by 12/31/22 will be entered as 2022 payments.

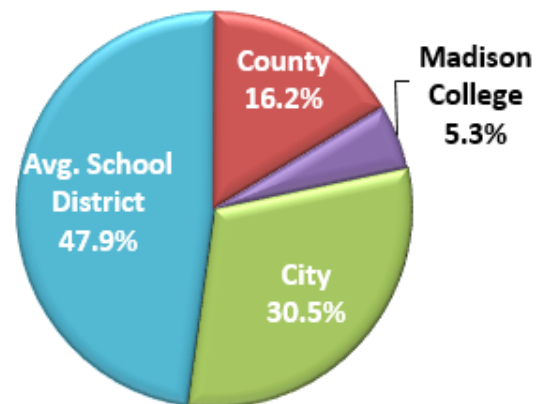
Dog Licensing

It is time for 2023 dog license and dog park renewals. Licenses can be renewed online or by mail. The license fee is \$20 for a spayed or neutered dog, \$25 for an unspayed for unneutered dog, and \$43 for a dog park permit. Visit www.cityofmiddleton.us > Departments > City Clerk > Licenses. Proof of rabies vaccination is required.

What Makes Up My Tax Bill?

Your tax bill includes allocations from several jurisdictions, not just the City of Middleton. Below is the average split by taxing authority for the 2022 tax year. The City is not responsible for setting the property tax rates for the other jurisdictions.
