

1-Jan	<b>Assessment Date</b>	Each calendar year, real and personal property is assessed by the assessor per its status as of January 1.
1-Mar	<b>Statement of Personal Property Due</b>	Form PA-003 must be received at the City of Middleton Assessor's office on or before the March 1st deadline.
1-Mar	<b>Property Tax Exemption Request Due</b>	Form PR-230 must be received by the City Assessor on or before the March 1st deadline.
Mid-April	<b>Statement of Assessment</b>	Assessment notices are mailed if the assessed value on a property changed from one year to the next
May	<b>Board of Review</b>	Must meet once within in a 30-day period beginning the 2 <sup>nd</sup> Monday in May
Spring-Summer	<b>Open Book Session</b>	7:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. at City Hall
Spring-Summer	<b>Board of Review</b>	9:00 a.m. at City Hall (to hear assessment objections)
15-Aug	<b><u>Equalized Values</u> Established</b>	Set by the Wisconsin Department of Revenue.
December	<b>Tax Bills</b>	Tax bills are required to be mailed by the third Monday in December
