City of Middleton Petition for State and Federal Aid for Improvements at Middleton Municipal Airport—Morey Field

The City of Middleton is considering petitioning the State of Wisconsin, Department of Transportation, for state and federal aid for potentially undertaking the following projects at Middleton Municipal Airport—Morey Field, 8300 Airport Road, Middleton, WI:

Prepare a Undertake Wildlife Site Visit/Assessment; Install VHF radio coverage to ground (RCO); Acquire Snow Removal Equipment; Purchase Mowing Equipment; Purchase Terminal Building; Replace and upgrade runway lighting, including Precision Approach Path Indicators (PAPIs) and Runway End Lights (REILs); Sealcoat and Crackfill airport pavements; Clear and maintain runway approaches as stated in Transportation Administrative Code Chapter 55; Make drainage improvements; and any necessary related work.

During the hearing, all interested persons will have an opportunity to present their opinions regarding the need for the petition and the proposed activities. Staff will enter into the record any opinions expressed verbally or in writing prior to the hearing. The Plan Commission may take action following the hearing.

Due to the public health emergency that has been declared for the COVID-19 outbreak, the City of Middleton is recommending that interested parties log in remotely rather than attend the meeting in person. However, the City can physically accommodate up to five members of the public in the meeting room at one time in a manner that adheres to state and national guidelines.
