

Voter Check In and Registering Voters

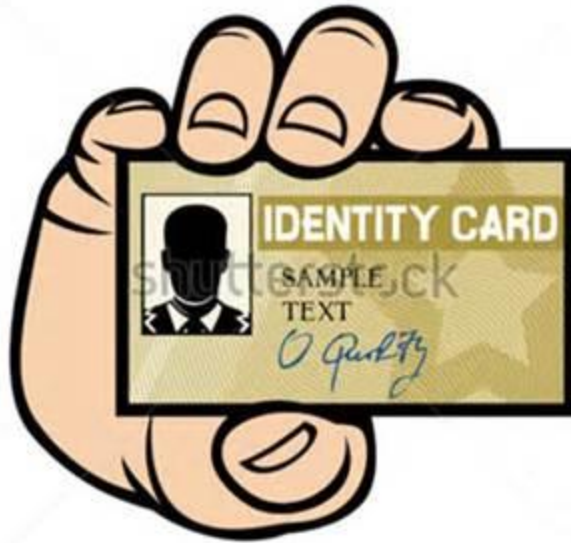
- **SAY** (their name and address)
SHOW (their photo ID)
&
SIGN (the poll book)

- ① Find their name
- ② Check for Absentee Notation
- ③ Check their Photo ID
- ④ Voter Signs their name
- ⑤ Issue a voter number and ballot
- ⑥ Direct them to voting booth

Voters Must Show Photo ID

Address does not need to match Poll Book!

- If elector does not have acceptable Photo ID offer then provisional ballot (get Chief)

WHAT PHOTO IDS CAN I USE TO VOTE IN WISCONSIN?

State of Wisconsin Driver License



Can be expired since November 6, 2018 (currently the last General Election)

State of Wisconsin ID Card



Can be expired since November 6, 2018 (currently the last General Election)

Wisconsin Driver License OR State ID Card Receipt

OR

WI DMV ID Petition Process Photo Receipt



Valid for 45 days from the date receipt was issued OR 180 days for the ID Petition Process Receipt

Veterans Affairs ID



Must be unexpired or have no expiration

U.S. Passport Book or Card



Can be expired since November 6, 2018 (currently the last General Election)

**Student ID Card
+
Enrollment Verification (only
if student ID is expired)**



Valid for voting if the expiration date is no more than 2 years from the date the card was issued. Still valid for voting if expired and accompanied by valid enrollment verification

U.S. Uniformed Services



Can be expired since November 6, 2018 (currently the last General Election)

Tribal ID Card



Still valid for voting if expired

Certificate of Naturalization



Only valid for voting if Certificate was issued not more than 2 years before the date of the election

Voters Must Sign Poll Book

- Tell them the rules- must sign or
 - DO NOT receive a ballot
- If elector cannot sign due to disability inspector indicates “exempt by order of inspectors” in signature space.
 - Can challenge elector (get chief inspector)
- If they sign an x or a line – okay if that is their typical signature
- If they sign Mickey Mouse etc. DO NOT give them a ballot



Absentee Voters at Polling Place

If an absentee ballot voter shows up to vote at the polling place on election day

“Absentee Issued; Absentee Returned” Notation

Notify the Chief Inspector

ABSENTEE RETURNED

1. If their ballot was returned –
 - They cannot vote a new ballot



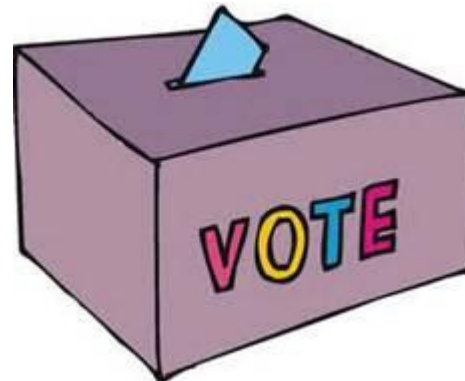
2. If their ballot was not returned – Absentee Issued Notation

ABSENTEE ISSUED

- They can vote a new ballot
- **“Voted in person”** will need to be recorded by their name on the absentee ballot log and the **inspector’s statement**

Challenging Electors

- If reason to believe elector does not meet qualifications to vote- May challenge
- Made by elector or inspector BEFORE a ballot is issued
- Document on Inspector's Statement
- Make copies



Other notes:

- Name change – must re-register (if ID has new name) otherwise vote with old name, discuss
- Typo – make notation in poll book
- Not on poll list
 - Check different variation of spelling
 - McGregor check McGregor as one word Mc Gregor as two
 - Van Dan check Vandan as one word Van Dan as two
 - Confirm at correct polling location, if so, must re-register
- If voter requires assistance –
 - Record name and address of assistor in poll book
 - Person who assists must certify the ballot
 - Record on Inspector's statement



Election Day Registrations

Are you qualified to Vote



- US Citizen
- 18 years or older on day of election
- Lived in Middleton for 28 days before the election
- You are registered to vote or are registering today

You may not vote if:

- You are here for temporary purposes only
- You have already voted in this election
- You are still required to report to a probation or parole officer because of a felony conviction
- You have been ruled incapable of voting by a judge

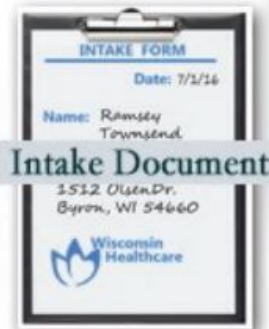
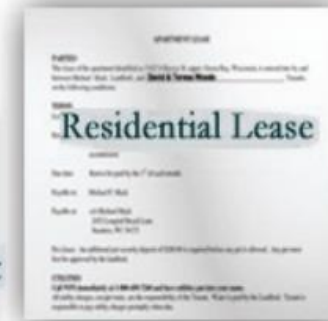
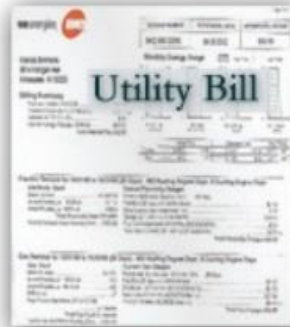
Proof of Residence Required (POR)



- Must provide Proof of Residence
 - If they have none **THEY DO NOT REGISTER OR VOTE - NO EXCEPTIONS**
- Proof of Residence **MUST BE CURRENT** on election day (cannot be expired)
- Proof of Residence Must include the voter's name and address



Acceptable Proof of Residence



Examples of POR that is not acceptable



- Checkbook
- Health Bills or Insurance documents
Statements/bills
- Home owner's insurance
- W-2
